### Report DSEI 2025



Report from our correspondents attending DSEI 2025, held in London, on last September, 9th to 12th. A comprehensive analysis of all the main news and trends in the land, naval, and air sectors. As far as Italy is concerned, the focus remains on the GCAP trinational (Italy, UK and Japan) programme for a 6th generation “aircraft system”. Among the other news related to the British Army programmes, it is noteworthy to mention the IFV version of the AJAX tracked vehicle and the ALCV 4x4 armoured vehicle, both presented at DSEI 2025. Many news in the missile sector, too, with MBDA presenting its new subsonic FC/ASW airframe, the STRATUS-LO (together with the STRATUS-RS, formerly the supersonic FC/ASW, the future cruise missile developed by UK, France and Italy.
